

What it is used for?


Abortion is the intentional termination of a pregnancy after conception. It allows women to put an end to their pregnancies.

Unintended pregnancy and abortion rates, by region, 2015-2019



- Roughly 121 million unintended pregnancies occurred each year between 2015 and 2019.
- Of these unintended pregnancies, 61% ended in abortion. This translates to 73 million abortions per year.


Types of abortion



- Medical Abortion: Taking the drug mifepristone, which is often called the "abortion pill". This pill is prescribed in the first trimester of a pregnancy.
- Surgical Abortion: Medical procedure that must be done in a clinic. There is actually more than one surgical option for abortion, it really all depends on how far along you are in your pregnancy.

Pro-Choice: for abortion

- Raped or incest victims should not be forced to carry out a pregnancy

Worth to note:

the US Supreme Court's 7-2 decision on Roe v. Wade declared the procedure a "fundamental right" on Jan. 22, 1973.




25 MILLION UNSAFE ABORTIONS TAKE PLACE EACH YEAR WORLWIDE


